

## School Council Minutes 16/1/20

<p><u>Discussions from the meeting:</u></p> <p><u>1. Book day.</u> Councillors were asked to find out the answers to two questions with their classes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Would you prefer to have book day on World Book Day in March (with little chance of a parade) or our own book day in June (with a much greater chance of a parade)?</li> <li>• Would you prefer to dress up as characters from one specific author, or any book character of your choice?</li> </ul> <p>One class had an equal amount of votes for both options. Two classes voted in favour for having it in March because "it's sooner." Eight classes said they'd prefer to have it in June because they like the parade. All classes agreed that they would like to be able to dress up as any character from a book.</p> <p><u>2. Homework</u> School councillors talked about homework being 4 (KS1) or 5 (KS2) types (in the week) of homework the school sets. They are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reading daily</li> <li>• Maths passports</li> <li>• Spellings</li> <li>• Learning facts from the knowledge planner</li> <li>• Times tables (KS2 and Y2)</li> </ul> <p>If children feel these are not being set then they should go and tell Miss Chalmers who will report it.</p>		<p><u>Issues reported by councillors:</u></p> <p><u>1. Basketballs</u> are getting lost or not being put away properly.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Councillors can speak to Mr S Lawlor to order new ones and Sports Leaders must make sure they return all equipment to the proper places.</li> </ul> <p><u>2. Boys</u> are saying that girls "can't play football."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• People who see this happening should tell an adult on duty. Football players should also make sure they choose a referee who knows the rules well, and split the teams evenly.</li> </ul> <p><u>3. There aren't enough cups</u> in the hall at lunchtime</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Chartwells have been asked to order more cups</li> </ul> <p><u>4. Some year groups</u> are going on the climbing frames when it isn't their turn</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children should tell an adult on duty who can stop this happening</li> </ul>
