Palazzola is just 18 miles / 29 Kms south of Rome and sited in 16 acres of oak, chestnut and pine woodlands. The Villa nestles high up on the shores of Lake Albano, an extinct volcano with the papal palace of Castel Gandolfo on the far side of the lake. Palazzola has superb views of the city of Rome and the Mediterranean Sea in the distance.

Palazzola has 54 rooms, a mix of singles and twins/doubles, some with full ensuite facilities. All are well furnished and comfortable and a number have stunning lake views. The arrangement of rooms around the cloister (the Old Wing) and in the New Wing makes Palazzola highly suitable for groups. In addition the self-contained area known as the Piazza Venezia has its own kitchenette with 3 twin rooms and one triple room, all ensuite. This makes it the ideal choice for small groups and families.

In summer lunch is served under the trees on the garden terrace, always a lovely experience and great for the appetite.
