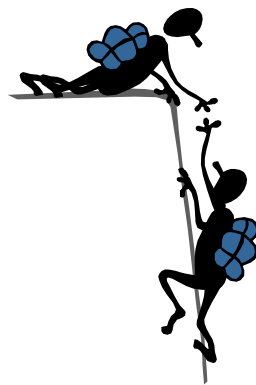

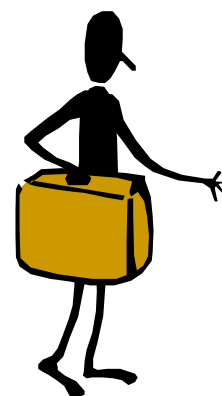
Most of the activities will take place outside regardless of the weather, it is therefore necessary for you to have suitable clothing/footwear and a waterproof coat or jacket.



WHAT TO BRING?

1. You will need a packed lunch for Monday.
2. Bedding
Please bring a sleeping bag and a pillow. All rooms have en-suite shower facilities.
3. Clothing
 - ✓ Arrive at school in sensible, comfortable clothing (**not school uniform**)
 - ✓ A change of clothes for each day (warm clothes suitable for outdoor activities) sensible footwear, e.g. outdoor shoes/boots.
 - ✓ A waterproof coat
 - ✓ Nightwear, slippers, dressing gown
 - ✓ A change of underwear for each day
 - ✓ A pair of indoor shoes or slippers (their school plimsolls will be fine)
4. Toiletries
 - Flannel)
 - Towel)
 - Soap/shower gel) In toiletry bag
 - Toothbrush/Toothpaste)
 - Hairbrush)

No make-up is necessary
5. You may bring a book or comic.
6. Please bring a pen and pencil. You will be given a diary to write a daily log to record information that will be needed back at school.
7. You may like to bring board games to play, e.g. Connect 4, Snakes & Ladders, Frustration etc....no valuables please!
8. A watch for time keeping as we will have busy action packed days.
9. Remember: The timetable for your visit is very full so **don't** bring computer games, radios, ipods etc.
10. Cameras will not be needed. Pictures will be taken and shared with you in school.



Parents please note that there are no facilities for children to make telephone calls. **Please do not allow your child to bring a mobile telephone.** One of the aims of this trip is to promote the children's independence but obviously in the case of an emergency the school will contact parents.
