# **The cost will be £425 for the week.**

This includes flights, the coach and entrance fees to all of the places we visit.

It includes four breakfasts and four dinners and two lunches at the Palazzola and one packed lunch supplied by the Palazzola.

It does not include lunch on Tuesday or Thursday, breakfast and dinner at the airports, ice cream or gifts.



# Monday



Your child will need to be at school and ready to leave at 4:30am. We expect to be leaving Heathrow at 7am to arrive at Rome Fiumicino at about 10:30am.

Children will not get a meal during the flight so they should bring a snack to have at the airport and sterling to buy a bottle of water at the airport.

A coach will transfer us to Villa Palazzola where we will have lunch before being taken to Castel Gandolfo for the afternoon.

Then it's back to the Villa to have supper. All lunches and dinners are 3 courses.

# Tuesday

## A day in the Vatican

After breakfast a coach will drop us at the Vatican. We'll spend the day in St Peter's and in the Vatican museum. We plan on visiting St Peter's, the Popes' Tombs and The Sistine Chapel.

We'll break the day with a lunch which we will buy in Rome.

A coach will collect us from St Peter's and return us to the Villa for the evening meal.



# Wednesday



Beach today!

After breakfast a coach will take us down the coast to visit Nettuno and Anzio.

We'll visit the Commonwealth War Graves and the American Graves at Anzio.

After the visit we'll have a packed lunch supplied by the Villa and then we'll go paddling in the sea (and have ice cream).

We will return to the Villa for our evening meal.

# Thursday

Rome!

After breakfast we will board our coach and head into Rome.

We'll visit churches, Il Vittoriano, the Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona, the Pantheon and the Colosseum.

We'll stop for snacks, site seeing and ice cream. We'll buy lunch in Rome. Then it's back to the Villa for supper.



# Friday 15<sup>th</sup>



## Homeward bound

After breakfast we will pack and then head off to the local town of Albano for site seeing and shopping. We then return to the Villa for lunch. After lunch we board the coach for the Catacombs of St Callixtus and then onto the airport.

We hope to get an early evening flight to London. Children will need to buy something to eat at Fiumicino's restaurants – 15 euro needed.

You'll receive a text when we board the coach and when we are 30 mins away from school.

# Next Steps

**Decide if your child will be coming!  
Speak to us if you have any concerns.**

Register your child for a place by paying a non-refundable £75 into the Rome 2019 ParentPay account by 12 noon on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> July. This covers the flight deposit.

Check your child's passport expiry date – ideally 6 months is needed. Info us immediately if your child has a non-EU or Italian passport.

Apply for an EHIC card:
