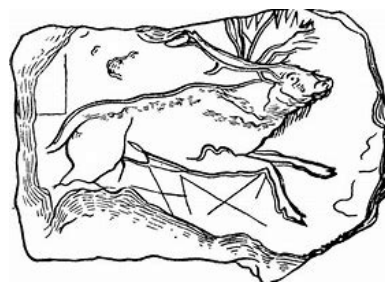

### ***Year 3 'Stone Age Survival Skills' Workshop***

To complement our history topic on changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, Year 3 will visit Gunnersbury Park Museum to take part in a practical outdoor learning experience to help them understand the lives of hunter-gatherers and early farmers and consider the importance of nature for human survival.

The children will investigate tools and materials used by Stone Age people and handle original and replica prehistoric artefacts in the museum. Outside in the park, they will be encouraged to identify potential sources of food and fuel, build shelters, try their hand at wattle and daub and use a saddle quern to grind corn.

There will be a cost of **£4.40 per child** for the workshop, which is payable via ParentPay by Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September. The trips will take place on the following dates:

**3M Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> September**

We will be travelling to the museum by public transport, leaving school at 9am and **returning slightly later than usual at about 4pm.**

Please send your child in with a **packed lunch** in a reusable sports-style bag and a bottle of **water**. They should also bring a **waterproof coat and comfortable shoes**, as we will be outside for a large part of the day, whatever the weather!
